

Short Narrative CV of Omer Van den Bergh

Omer Van den Bergh is emeritus professor Health Psychology at the University of Leuven. He is an expert in the broad area of the relationship between health and behavior. Specific key words in his work are symptom perception and (respiratory) psychophysiology in response to stress and aversive somatic experiences. His research involves both normal subjects in laboratory experiments, clinical studies on psychosomatic and pulmonary patients in the university hospital, and field studies on subjective health symptoms. In November 2018, he received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the International Society for Behavioral Medicine (ICBM, Santiago, Chile).
