Pim Cuijpers, Ph.D. is full professor of Clinical Psychology at the Department of Clinical, Neuro and Developmental Psychology, Amsterdam Public Health research institute, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, The Netherlands. He is also director of the [WHO Collaborating Centre for Research and Dissemination of Psychological Interventions](#) in Amsterdam.

He is specialised in conducting randomised controlled trials and meta-analyses on prevention and psychological treatments of common mental disorders across the life span. Much of his work is aimed at prevention of mental disorders, psychological treatments of depression and anxiety disorders, and Internet-delivered treatments.

He has also published on several other research topics, including global mental health, student mental health, and psycho-oncology. Pim Cuijpers has [published more than 1,175 peer-reviewed papers, chapters, reports and professional publications, including more than 950 papers in international peer-reviewed scientific journals](#).

He is on the Thomson-Reuter Web of Science lists of the 'highly cited researchers' since the first edition of this list in 2014 (<http://highlycited.com/>). In Web of Science (Clarivate InCites Essential Science Indicators) he is currently ranked number 1 in the field of psychiatry/psychology as top author. According to Expertscape, an organisation that ranks researchers by their expertise in biomedical topics, professor Cuijpers is the world's number one top expert on research on [psychotherapy](#), the number one top expert on [depression](#), and the number two on [meta-analyses](#).

He has visiting professorships at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Turku, Finland | Babeş-Bolyai University, Cluj-Napoca, Romania | University of Hongkong. He is currently Editor-in-Chief of the [Journal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology](#).
